Effectiveness of a Traits Cooperative Learning on Developing Writing Achievement and Composition among Teacher Candidates

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Abstract : This article reports investigations of a study into the effectiveness of a traits cooperative learning (TCL) on teacher candidates' writing achievement, composition, and attitudes towards traits of writing approach and small group learning. Mixed methodologies were used with the participants in a repeated measures quasi-experimental design. Forty-two class teacher candidates, enrolled in the Bahrain Teachers College, completed the pre and post author-developed measures. The results suggest that TCL has a positive effect on the participants' writing achievement, composition, and attitudes towards small group learning. Further implications to teacher education are presented.
