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## International Student Recruitment in Higher Education: A Comparative Study of the Countries in the Middle East

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**Abstract :** Historical and ancestral bonds of the countries in the Middle East have led to similarities in culture and context of their societies. In addition, economic resources, such as the oil industry, have generally been an integrative point in the region.
