Towards an Indigenous Language Policy for National Integration

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Abstract : The paper is about the need for an indigenous language in order to meaningfully harness both our human and material resources for the nation's integration. It then examines the notty issue of the national language question and advocates a piece meal approach in solving the problem. This approach allows for the development and use of local languages in minority areas, especially in Benue State, as a way of preparing them for consideration as possible replacement for English language as Nigeria's national or official language. Finally, an arrangement to follow to prepare the languages for such competition at the national level is presented.

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
