

The Effect of Gender on the Three Types of Aggression among Kuwaiti Children

Abstract : Child aggression is a serious social problem that affects children's lives. This study examines the relationship between three types of aggressive behaviors—physical, verbal, and indirect aggression—from sociocultural and social work perspectives. Also, it investigates the effect of gender on the three types of aggressive behaviors and the most frequently used aggressive behaviors among a sample of 329 Kuwaiti children. The results show that there is a positive correlation between the three types of aggression and gender.
