The Effect of Gender on the Three Types of Aggression among Kuwaiti Children

Abstract : Child aggression is a serious social problem that affects children's lives. This study examines the relationship between three types of aggressive behaviors-physical, verbal, and indirect aggression-from sociocultural and social work perspectives. Also, it investigates the effect of gender on the three types of aggressive behaviors and the most frequently used aggressive behaviors among a sample of 329 Kuwaiti children. The results show that there is a positive correlation between the three types of aggression and gender.
