

Analysis of Economic Development Challenges of Rapid Population Growth in Nigeria: Way Forward

Abstract : Nigeria is a high fertility country that experiences eye-popping population growth, with no end in sight. However, there is evidence that its large population inhibits government's efforts in meeting the basic needs of the people.
