The Iranian Law and Refugee Survivors of Sexual and Gender-Based Violence

Abstract: This paper intends to explore the existing safeguards available within the Iranian law in protecting refugees affected by Sexual and Gender-Based Violence (SGBV). The Iranian law afforded protection for women and girls against SGBV is scattered across various bodies of law.
