

Annexation (Al-Idāfah) in Thariq bin Ziyad's Speech

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Abstract : Annexation is a typical construction that commonly used in Arabic language. The use of the construction appears in Arabic speech such as the speech of Thariq bin Ziyad. The speech as one of the most famous speeches in the history of Islam uses many annexations.
